

What Helps Us Learn To Read?

- We practise reading with prosody so we can improve our fluency
- Practising reading sections of the text helps us to become fluent readers
- Listening to the adult model fluent reading helps me to get better at reading
- We read in EVERY subject EVERY DAY at all times of the day
- I love the novels we read in English. We read the entirety of the book and the stories we read are excellent
- We reread texts and parts of texts in English and in other subjects to help us with comprehension
- Sometimes we read the text three times to help us understand it
- My teacher goes through vocabulary we might not know before we read the text
- We revise vocabulary and the meanings of words all of the time
- My English knowledge book helps me to revise word meanings at home
- We have reading for pleasure time built into our day
- We read out loud in English lessons and in other subjects in the afternoons
- We perform poetry and practise reading the poem out loud which is really fun
- Our reading for pleasure books encourage me to read books I haven't read before
- Book appreciation time helps me pick the next book I want to read
- Coming to the front and reading out loud to everyone makes me feel confident and I read better
- Reading certificates encourage me to read at home
- My teacher checks who is reading every week and this helps me stay on track with my reading at home
- Guided reading with my teacher has helped me improve my reading
- Reading with an adult 1 to 1 helps me get better at reading
- The reading corner in my classroom makes me want to curl up with a book
